

Worksheet 3: Etwinning project: The Revolution of books Questionnaire about reading and books by Dr Gaia Ierace

Pair work: Work with a partner and ask them questions. Take notes about what they say and be prepared to report to the classes during the meeting.

1. How often do you read?

4. Is there a genre you don't like reading? Which one and why?
5. Why is reading important for you?
6. Why are well-read people better at speaking in your opinion?
7. When you read you can travel in time and space, why is this an enriching experience?
8. After reading some books at school, what have you learnt?
9. When you present a book to the public, which aspects should you mention? Author, plot, what you liked, genre, time of publication, what else?
10. Imagine you must write a review of your favourite book, what would you write? Try to write a review of your favourite book, remember that the point is to convince your reader to buy the book.
